Cleaning the Platen Roller and Printhead

Clean the platen roller and printhead after every five rolls of labels or when you see voids in the print.




Correct Print

- 1. Remove any loaded labels.
- 2. Use a plastic knife to snap off the supply slot cover.




3. Use the plastic knife to press the L-shaped bar and the platen roller pops out.

Note: Art is cut-away to show detail.





4. Clean the platen roller and printhead using a cotton swab moistened with isopropyl alcohol.Caution: Do not use sharp or pointed objects to remove labels. It may damage the printer.



- 5. Allow time for the parts to dry.
- 6. Replace the platen roller.
- 7. Snap the cover into place.
- 8. Reload the labels. See the Operator's Handbook for more information.
